John - Friend - Mentor

On October 11, 2003, nationally known, and long time K.C. Woodturners Club member, John Shackelford, passed away. John has been a member of our club since about 1995, serving as president in 2000. He was a remarkably talented turner, teacher, and friend. John turned a wide range of projects including large spheres, hollow forms, bowls, platters, and Christmas ornaments of all kinds. His most recent projects were the world's fanciest segmented biscuit cutters. He collaborated with his good friend Pete Stiglich, to produce turning tools, primarily small tools for use in hollowing small projects. These tools are well-known around the club as "Shackelich" tools. Anyone lucky enough to own one knows how well they work.

John's professional working career was spent as a finish carpenter in Apache, Oklahoma, and the Kansas City area. He had tremendous technical knowledge of woodworking and a practical knowledge that can only come after spending many years in the field. Once when John was in my shop, I mentioned that my front door would not stay open. I asked John if he

could show me how to fix it or replace it. John removed one of the hinge pins, took it out to the front walkway, whacked it in the center with a hammer, and reinstalled it in the hinge. The bent pin created enough friction to hold the door open and it continues to work well more than two years later.

John would gladly share his knowledge about woodworking with anyone. If you had a question, John would either invite you to his well-equipped shop or come to yours. He was a great teacher. Most of us are much better turners today because John generously spent hours with us showing us how to better use our lathes and tools.

John was a founding member of our club's "church group." We are a small group of people who regularly turn wood together, and meet each Sunday morning at Woodcraft for "Sunday School." We usually discuss lathes, tools, projects, and even manage to gossip some. We continue to meet, share stories, and remember our friend John Shackelford. Our best wishes and prayers go out to his wife, Connie, and the rest of his family.
