### German Potato Salad

5 lbs red potatoes

1 lb bacon

1 large onion

2 cups sugar

1 cup vinegar

½ cup cornstarch

Boil potatoes in peelings until done. (or cook in the microwave, warped in plastic wrap.) Let cool and peel. Mash into small pieces. Cook bacon until crisp. Crumble bacon and add to potatoes. Copy onion and add to mixture. (Some prefer to cook onion in bacon drippings before adding to the mixture.) Pour bacon drippings over mixture. In small saucepan, combine sugar, vinegar and bring to a boil. Mix cornstarch with a small amount of cold water. Add to boiling vinegar/sugar mixture. Cook until thickened. Pour over potato mixture. Mix well. Serve warm. Can be served in a crock-pot
