# **July Demonstrator Jerry Darter**

Jerry's topic was turning a bowl from a log. He showed how to mount the bowl blank on a lathe using a screw chuck, with the tailstock as a safety. He then rounded the bowl and formed a spigot for the 4-jaw chuck. The next step was to reverse the bowl on the lathe, chuck the spigot, and turn the inside of the bowl. The final step was to use a jam chuck to reverse-turn the bowl and finish the bowl's foot. Jerry made it look easy.
