

Three 20-Minute Woodturning Demo Vignettes

Chip Siskey, Merle Schneck, and Anthony Harris each gave a 20minute short demonstration on one of their favorite subjects.

Chip showed how to temporarily attach and easily remove a chucked waste block from a woodturning. Merle imparted his knowledge of lathe tool grinding fixtures and showed how to get repeatable results with your grinding setup. Anthony demonstrated tool technique for making plane cuts, standard beads, coves, etc. as well as how to make a vee-thingie.


Top Turning Event, September 9th
