

Kip Christensen, PhD, is a professor of Industrial Design in the School of Technology at Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah. His primary teaching areas include furniture design and prototyping. He is also an accomplished and well-known woodturner. His work has been published in over 20 books and in a variety of magazines and journals, and displayed in many galleries and international juried exhibitions. Kips' work is housed in numerous collections, both public and private. He has given over 150 national and several international presentations. In 1999 Kip was appointed coordinator of the Utah Woodturning Symposium, the longest running woodturning symposium in the world. While he is best known for his lidded containers, he is also comfortable working with bowls, vessels, spindles and production turning. He has pioneered the use of elk and moose antler as a medium for artistic turning; his work is characterized by clean lines and fine detail. Gallery curator and author Kevin Wallace wrote" The work of Kip Christensen is always aesthetically pure and technically precise".
