May Meeting Woodturning Demonstration:

Square-Edged Woodturning with Chip Siskey





Our own KCWT member Chip Siskey will demonstrate his technique of inside-out woodturning. Chip has been a member of Kansas City Woodturners and the Northland Woodturners for a number of years and he has honed his talents well.

For those of you who don't know what square-edged woodturning might be, it is a great example of a technique called "how'd he make that?" According to Chip, it involves cutting a block of wood into four pieces, temporarily gluing them back together with scrap wood between the pieces, turning the outside, removing the scrap pieces, then re-gluing the four pieces. The result is a round bowl with corners. Impossible?

Expect Chip's demo to be informative and interesting to every level of woodturner.
