Bowtie Bowl Inlays with Parker Nicholson







Our own KCWT member Parker Nicholson demonstrated his methods of saving cracked wooden bowls using inserted wooden bowties. Parker said he doesn't use the bowties to pull the cracks shut, but rather to control any further cracking. The cracks become a "feature" for the bowl with the bowties drawing the eyes to the cracked area. This is another useful technique for the woodturner's bag of tricks.
