

The 2008 auction was a success. We raised \$5,119.50. Once again, Eddie Powers was our auctioneer, and as usual did a great job. Thanks to all the members who donated many valuable items to the auction. Thanks also to all who came and bid on all the stuff we had. Many members brought guests, and quite a few members of the Kansas City Woodworkers Guild joined us.

Since the auction began in 1999, approximately \$31,000.00 has been raised for the club.

The auction committee consisting of Dick Woodhouse and Bud Schenke put in many long hours getting ready for the auction. During the course of this auction season we sent out 110 letters of solicitation and 90 follow up reminder letters. This brought in 160 items from 40 contributors, for which thank you letters, with pictures of the items on display, have been sent. The auction was attended by 66 members and guests.
