He reached into the box and brought out one project at a time to discuss the thought process and planning that went into creating and producing the project. This bowl was wrapped in rope and epoxied, creating an interesting surface effect.











This spiral base bowl started out as two bowls.

The ceramic coffee cup at left was the inspiration for trying to make this shape from one piece of wood. The end product was successful. Getting to the end product was very complicated.









Two other projects were a bowl inside a bowl and an intricately stained bowl.

This Don Frank project was published as an article in AAW's American Woodturner magazine. Don was already good at air brushing fish because he was a professional taxidermist for many years. He showed how the fish sculpture started out as a hollow turning and progressed to the final product.

Kansas City Woodturners Club August 2025 Monthly Meeting




Welcome to all Members and Guests! (In-Person and via Zoom!)
