September Demonstration



Springfield, MO woodturner, Larry Randolph, demonstrated how he makes his unique turned bird houses. These are suitable for tree ornaments but could be made any size you like.

The process for turning a small bird house requires several steps, which are outlined below. Please watch the recording of the meeting to learn more from Larry about the process. Directions are below.

- 1. Mount the blank for the roof in a chuck.
- 2.Drill a 1 1/8 inch hole in the roof.
- 3. Turn the bottom of the roof
- 4. Remove the roof and set aside.
- 5. With the same chuck, mount the bottom of the bird house blank.
- 6. Drill a 3/4 inch hole in the base/bottom.
- 7. Turn the bank round and start to shape the top.
- 8. Turn a tenon to fit the into the roof.













Directions Cont.

- 9. Drill a small hole (size is a preference—1/4" was used for this project) for the bird entrance and dowl for purch.
- 10. Finish turning the top portion of the house.
- 11.Remove from chuck.
- 12.Instill pin chuck and mount the house.
- 13. Finish turning the house and remove from chuck.
- 14. Mount the roof to the pin chuck and finish turning the roof.
- 15.Optional—add texture and paint.
- 16.Glue together
- 17.Add an eye screw and any decor






















The 2025 KC Irish Fest August 29-30-31, 2025
