Finishing Techniques with Craig Arnold

From preventing blotching and uneven color to understanding how different finishes bond and perform, Craig Arnold's recent demonstration provided valuable insight for woodturners of all experience levels.

Craig, from the Kansas City Woodworkers' Guild, shared practical techniques for sealing wood before staining to achieve more consistent and attractive results. He also explained the characteristics of various finishes and how to select the most appropriate finish based on the wood, the intended use of the project, and the desired appearance.

There was a tremendous amount of useful information packed into this demonstration—far more than can be adequately summarized in a newsletter article. The finishing process is complex and best experienced through the full demonstration.

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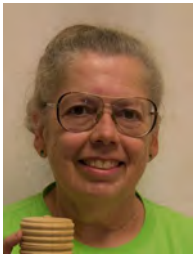

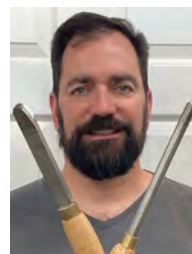
