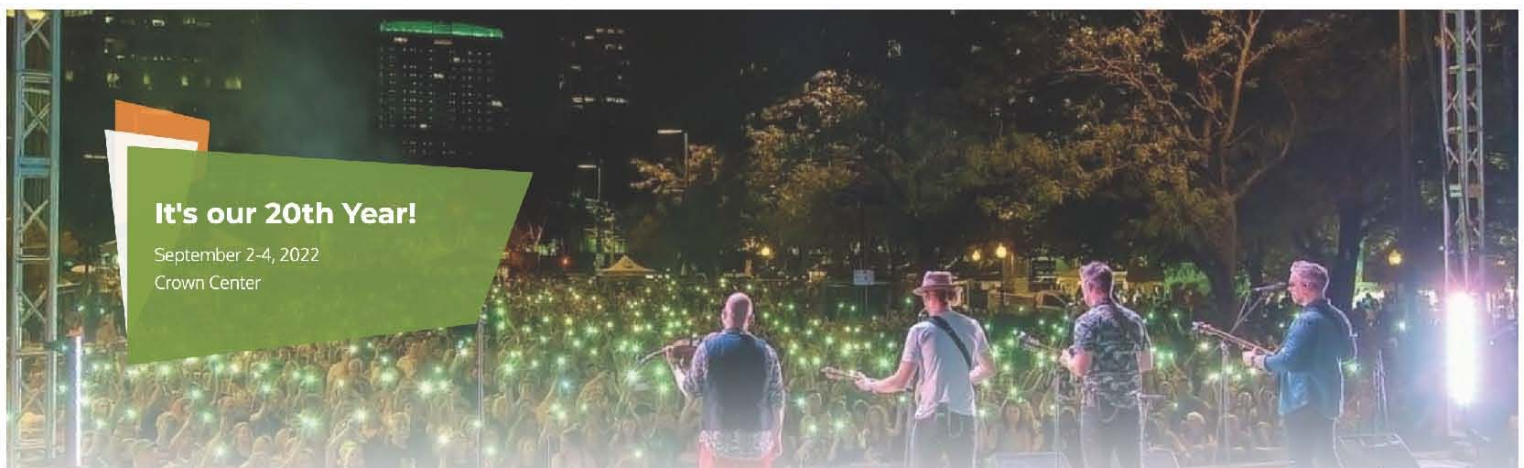

A copy of Phill's steps to complete his project can be viewed or downloaded from the club's library. It includes the steps as well as drawings to help you through the process.



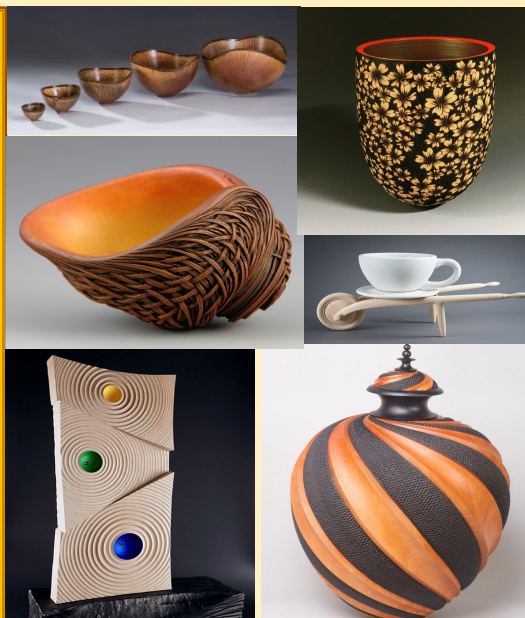

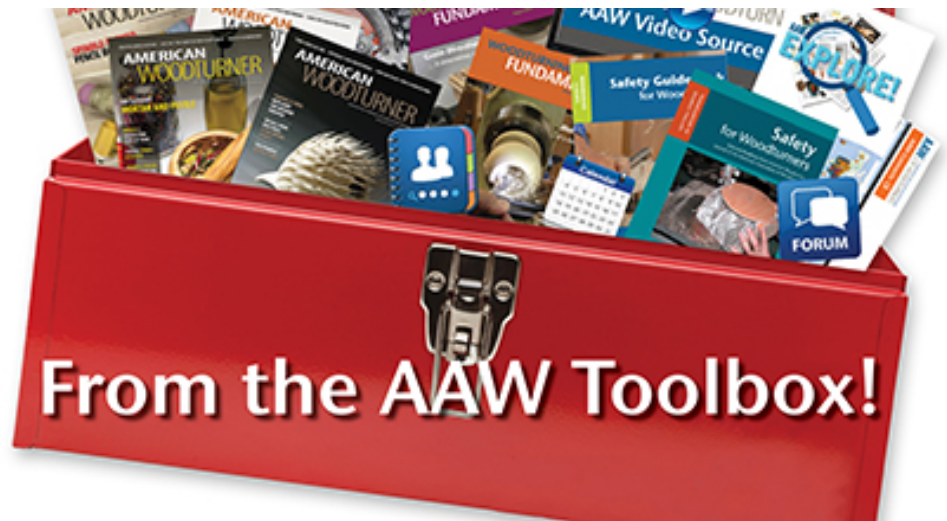
