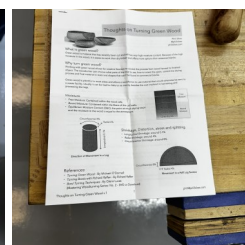
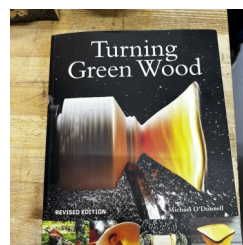
Speaking of Donations, If you have donated time, talent or especially money, THANK YOU!!. We will always take your donations.

Safety Minute

Phil talked about Safety when turning Green wood

1. Wear a Face shield—Protect your eyes from flying wood-chips
2. Stand out of the way—Stand to the side so you are out of the line of fire if the piece comes unattached.
3. Turn left handed — This helps keep you out of the way naturally.
4. Start slow and then increase.
