Safety Minute

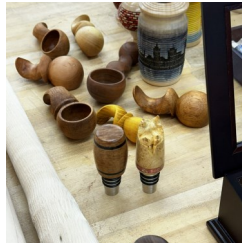
No Safety Minute was formally presented at this month's meeting.
