Upcoming classes will be available. In July, Anthony will present a Spindle Class over three days, Sat/Sun 7/13-14, and Sat 7/20. Space is limited

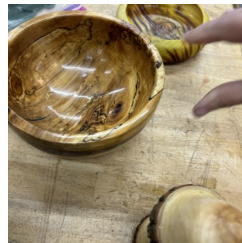

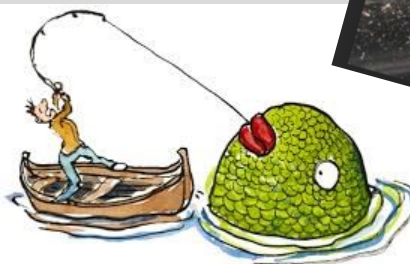
